Saturday, April 23 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 pm.

Dumpsters will be located at borough hall and all trash must be brought to this location. **RESIDENTS ONLY! IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED. PLEASE NOTE: NO CONTRACTORS, TIRES, BATTERIES, PAINT, OR OIL.** Small branches and twigs will be accepted. Residents are required to unload their vehicles.

STREET SWEEPING

The street sweeper will be in the borough **Thursday, April 28 and Friday, April 29.** Cars parked on the street sweeping routes will be towed at the owners' expense. There will be **NO PARKING** on the street until the sweeper has completed that area. Signs will be removed once the area is available for parking.
