There will be **NO PARKING** on street until the sweeper has completed that area. Signs will be removed once the area is available for parking.

FREE SPRING CLEAN UP - NO ELECTRONICS Saturday, June 5 from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 pm.

Dumpsters will be located at borough hall and all trash must be brought to this location. RESIDENTS ONLY! IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED. PLEASE NOTE: NO CONTRACTORS, TIRES, BATTERIES, PAINT, OR OIL. Small branches and twigs will be accepted. Residents are required to unload their vehicles.

APPLIANCE PICK UP DAY

The appliances will be collected **Wednesday**, **June 9**. The cost is \$5 or \$10 for an appliance containing Freon. Please put the money in an envelope with your address and phone number along with a list of appliances and place the envelope in the red mailbox at the entrance to Boro Hall. Deadline to sign up is Friday, June 4.

DIRT PILES & LEAF PICK UP

The borough crew will be picking up dirt piles on Mondays in April and May. Leaves will be collected every other Tuesday during April and May beginning April 20. Leaves must be bagged, placed curbside, and weigh no more than 10 lbs. If there are sticks or trash, bags will not be collected.

QUALITY OF LIFE ORDINANCE

Summer is around the corner, grass and weeds will begin to grow. The borough will be enforcing the weed ordinance. A courtesy letter will be issued and after 7 days from receipt of letter if weeds and grass are not cut, citations will be issued with no further warning. Remember to keep sidewalks clean.

WEEKLY GARBAGE COLLECTION

Garbage cannot be curbside until 7:00 p.m. Tuesday evening. Please remove any containers within 24 hours of pickup. One large item is allowed on the first pickup of the month.

DELINQUENT SANITATION ACCOUNTS

If a Sanitation Account is delinquent two quarters, service will be **suspended** until payment is received. A lien will be placed on the property once you exceed 2 quarters. Service will not be restored until past due amount including costs are paid.
